Arimatsu is a neighborhood within Nagoya that appears largely as it did in the Edo period. Located between the post towns of Chiryu and Narumi on the Old Tokaido Road linking Edo (Tokyo) and Kyoto, the village prospered as a production area for tie-dyeing. Arimatsu Narumi Shibori tie-dyeing techniques have been passed down to this day as a traditional craft, and the once thriving merchant townscape continues to convey the prosperity of the past.
