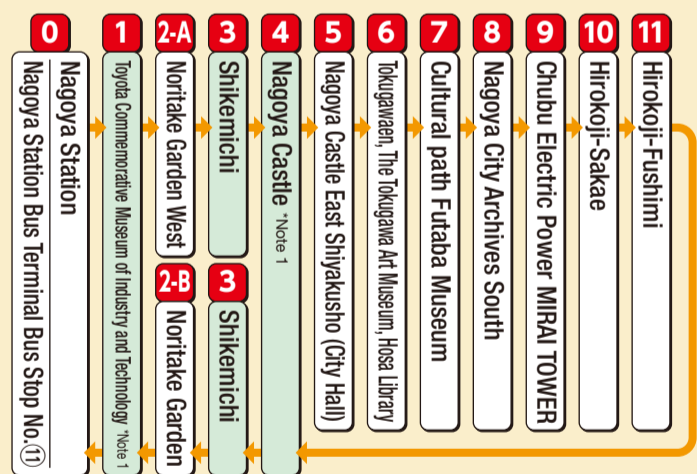

Information

In Service Tuesday to Sunday



Weekdays: Bus departs every 30-60 minutes
Weekends and Holidays: Bus departs every 20-30 minutes
Closed: Every Monday (or the following day if Monday is a holiday), year-end and New Year's holidays (December 29th - January 3rd)



*The bus leaving at 17:00 from Nagoya Station will operate on a shorter route and will not stop at 1 Nagoya Castle, 2 Shikemichi, 3 Noritake Garden, and 4 Toyota Commemorative Museum of Industry and Technology on the way back.
*Note 1: Outbound and inbound buses use the same stations. Take care not to mistake the direction.

*Each ticket is valid for one person only. You can use it as many times as you like throughout the day.
*Valid only for Me-guru and C-758 buses.
*Please show the date stamp on the reverse side of your ticket to the conductor when boarding the bus.
*Available for purchase on the Me-guru Bus, Oasis 21 i Center, Kanayama Tourist Information Center, and Transportation Bureau Service Centers (Nagoya Station, Kanayama Station, Sakae Station).

Information about riding the Nagoya Sightseeing Route Bus Me-guru.
*Weekend eco-tickets and one-day bus & subway combination tickets issued by the Transportation Bureau can be used.
*The "manaca" IC card is also valid.
*Welfare railway tickets (senior's pass etc.) are valid as well.
*Commuter passes and nagoya subway 24-hour tickets are not valid.

At 1 and 4, buses arrive and leave from a single bus stop on the outbound (to Nagoya Castle) and the return routes (to Nagoya Station). At 3, there are separate bus stops for the outbound (to Nagoya Castle) and return routes (to Nagoya Station). Please take care not to get on the wrong bus.

Table with columns: Bus Stop, Weekday service time table (Bus departs at 30-60 minutes intervals), Short Route. Rows include stops from 0 to 11.

Table with columns: Bus Stop, Saturday/Sunday/Holiday service time table (Bus departs at 20-30 minutes intervals), Short Route. Rows include stops from 0 to 11.

*Buses are operated with the holiday time schedule from Aug. 13 through Aug. 15.
