City's landmark tower built in 1954 as Japan's first consolidated radio tower. It is Japan. In addition to the observation decks situated 90 m and 100 m above ground level, the 3rd floor has a café where visitors can relax and enjoy the view of the Sakae cityscape and a gift shop that sells original products. Floors 4 and 5 are now a hotel. One of the tower's attractions is the lighting up at night.
