Toyota Commemorative Museum of Industry and Technology
Industrial heritage center where visitors can learn the roots of TOYOTA.



Noritake Garden
Noritake ceramics facility. Visitors can enjoy factory tours, museum with Old Noritake tableware, shopping, or painting.



Nagoya City Science Museum
Everyone can enjoy science with nearly 220 different exhibits, including the world's largest planetarium, *Brother Earth*.



The Tokugawa Art Museum
A great collection of several thousands of invaluable items of the Tokugawa family including nine national treasures.



Oasis 21
Three-dimensional park that is themed on "Spaceship Aqua" with restaurants, shops and bus terminals.



Nagoya TV Tower
Symbol of the Sakae area that offers unobstructed panoramic views of Nagoya city.



Osu Kannon Temple & Osu Shopping District
Dynamic shopping area containing over 1,200 shops and restaurants, and popular Buddhist temple.



Atsuta Jingu Shrine
Shrine dedicated to one of the three sacred treasures.



Port of Nagoya Public Aquarium
About 2 million visitors annually. Enjoy a dynamic Dolphin Performance and various kinds of water creatures.



SCMagLEV and Railway Park
Exhibition includes the Superconducting Maglev and generations of Shinkansen as well as historic rolling stock.



LEGOLAND JAPAN
Family can enjoy the many rides, Lego® models to play and build with, and attractions themed on the Lego block world.



Arimatsu&Narumi Tie-Dyeing Museum
