“Ikebana” is one of Japan’s traditional arts.

The “Saga Goryu” school is said to have a tradition spanning over 1,200 years. It began in the early Heian period when Emperor Saga placed a blooming chrysanthemum from Osawa Pond in Daikakuji Temple into a flower vase.

Because it expresses the harmony between the sky, the land, and people, it has served as the foundation of Ikebana.

Even a single branch or flower has its own life.

The essence of Ikebana is to capture the beauty of nature in a vase, finding elegance in the flow of branches and leaves, and in the spaces between the flowers.

Through Ikebana, you can not only feel the changing seasons and calm your mind, but also refine your aesthetic sensibility.

Let’s enjoy the “Saga Goryu” school of Ikebana, where nature resonates with your heart!
